Bruges lace has a few basic motifs including flowers, scrolls, and leaves connected by trails and fillings. Students will begin with a basic flower motif with variations. More advanced students will continue their exploration with more complicated patterns. Choose from a variety of prickings to expand your vocabulary.

This class is designed for those wishing to explore (beginning) and perfect (continuing) traditional Bruges lace. Lace students will learn the basic tape, plaits and picots, several types of flowers, and the scroll. Continuing students will learn how to navigate the fillings and some additional Bruges techniques. Students will work at their own pace with patterns provided or may bring patterns to discuss and explore possible working solutions.

Elizabeth Peterson is from Salt Lake City, UT, and began making lace in 1985 and teaching in 1996. She teaches several types of lace weekly and has taught lace at IOLI Conventions and Winter Lace Conferences. She believes lacemaking is fun and challenging and a great way to spend your time.
